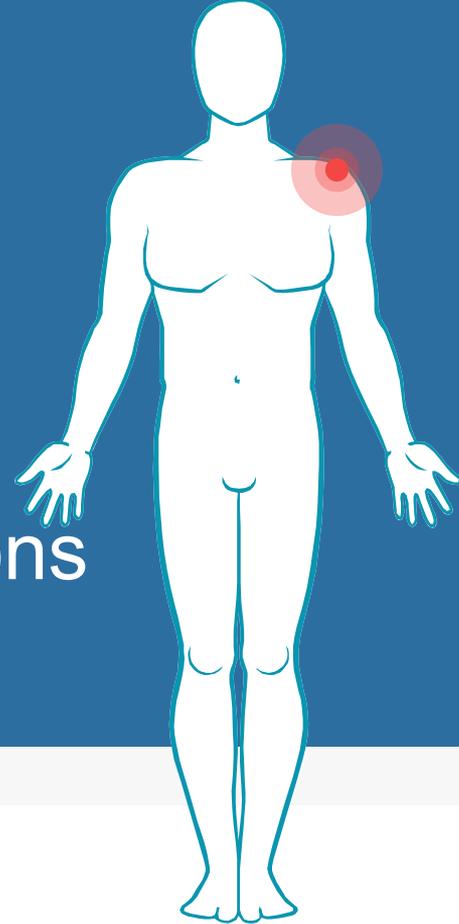

How to fight technology addiction

- Try not to be bored often – if you spend your day in an active, productive way you won't have time to constantly check your phone
- Avoid bringing phone or tablet to bed
- Turn off all of your devices from time to time to catch breath and enjoy the moment



How to fight technology addiction

- Limit time spent on social media, playing games etc. to specific period of time daly (e.g. no more than two houres)
- Turn off notifications





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
